By this e-mail I'll like to invite young people from our worldwide network to participate free of charge in a wonderful performing art project in August 2009 in Denmark.

In cooperation with Theatre en Vol from Sardinia the participants will make a street performance with a climate theme to be shown in Silkeborg and in Copenhagen the 14th and 15th August.

- 20-25 people from 18 years and up from all over the world can participate with free food, lodging and training.
- 5-10 people from other continents of the world might get full transport support.
- Europeans must pay own transportation, but can apply for support.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old.

COME2gether – a climate dialogue across borders

The context of the project is the world summit on climate (COP15) that will take place in Copenhagen in December 2009.



It is important that civil society and artists send a message to the COP15 summit and the Danish Government has supported financially, that Danish Folk High Schools can have climate, world citizenship and sustainable development on the agenda prior to the world summit. 1000 people from the whole world will participate in a Folk High School Climate Camp in Denmark in August 2009.

The overall project is called **COME2gether - climate dialogue across borders** and will be a platform for engaging public events locally and in Copenhagen.

The scrap camp at Performers House

Performers House will participate in the Come2gether project with **The scrap camp**, where the participants will express visions of a more sustainable world through the performing arts.



The resurrection passes also through our capacity to bestow dead objects with new life! Bizarre machines will be constructed from scrap material, become alive and start to resound in the hands of percussionists of the Brigade of Urban Harmonisation. The street performance will be based upon urban percussions, the work of street theatre performers and the construction of theatrical machines out of scrap material. The camp will be nurtured and challenged by the cultural encounters and various cultural and professional approaches.

On the camp the participants will outline visions, dreams and utopias and transform them to an artistic street performance and you will meet teachers from Theatre en Vol, Sardinia, and from Performers House. They will guide the artistic process into a `street performance`,

Workshops:

1. Dreams – vision – utopia (Michèle Kramers, Holland/Italy)
2. Urban percussion (Denis Cabacho, France)
3. Theatrical action workshop (Mariapaola Cordella, Italy)
4. Construction of theatrical machines with scrap materials (Puccio Savioli, Italy)

Camp Period: Sunday 9 August to Saturday 15 August 2009

Price: 3400 DKK (457 €) - including board and lodging.
